The Information System shall be implemented on a nationwide basis through MAFWE and PEMP branch offices, with Operational Acceptance to be achieved within 15 months from the Contract Effective Date, at sites specified in Section VII, Purchaser's Requirements
- 3. The procurement process will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Proposals (RFP) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" September, 2025 Seventh Edition ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Proposers as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
- 4. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation process set out in the bidding documents. The following weightings shall apply for Rated Criteria (including technical and non-price factors): 40 percent and for Bid cost: 60 percent.
